

# PCI HEALTH CARD

## *making your life easier.*

**YOUR PCI HEALTH CARD (HRA)** can be used to pay for co-payments, co-insurance, and deductibles. But that's not all. You can also use your card to pay for many expenses in the following categories: Medical, Dental Care, Eye Care, and Over-the-Counter (OTC) medications and products.

Insurance Premiums (e.g., HMO premiums, employer-sponsored health insurance plan premiums)
Maternity Clothes
Medical Savings Account (MSA)/Health Saving Account (HSA) Contributions
Medicare B and D Premiums
Nutritional Supplements
Personal Use Items
Swimming Lessons
Teeth Whitening
Veterinary Fees
Weight-Loss Program not part of specific disease treatment
